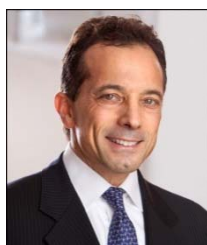
of business administration with an emphasis on transportation and logistics. She earned a master of business administration from the University of Phoenix in 2002.
