Mike Wilson is currently Chief Executive Officer at Consolidated Chassis Management (CCM) in Budd Lake, NJ. CCM is the leading cooperative chassis pool manager, managing the combined fleet of multiple contributors in providing maximum fluidity to intermodal freight transport. CCM works closely with steamship lines, equipment providers, railroads, ports and motor carriers at over 200 locations nationwide. CCM manages the South Atlantic Chassis Pool, providing chassis provision services in Savannah and other ports in the South Atlantic Region, as well as Atlanta, Charlotte, Memphis, Nashville and Huntsville.

Prior to his position at CCM Mike was Senior Vice President of Business Operations for Hamburg Süd North America where he was responsible for all Marine & Terminal Operations, Equipment & Intermodal, Finance & Accounting, Information Technology, Human Resources, Quality Management and Administration. Mike has over 40 years of experience in International Shipping & Logistics, where his past duties have included senior positions in Logistics, Operations, and Customer Service covering a geographical scope that includes North America, Europe, Central America, the Caribbean and North Coast of South America.
