2027 SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

The Traffic Club of New York, Inc. is proud to announce that we plan to award several scholarships this year, as we have since 2001. The award may be used for either tuition or education-related expenses.

The eligibility requirements are as follows:

- 1) Candidate must be either a child or grandchild of a paid-up member in good standing.
- 2) The member must be a current “listed” member with a minimum of the past two full consecutive years membership prior to the date of application. Feel free to confirm eligibility prior to submitting an application.
- 3) Candidate must be a senior in High School or undergraduate in College, pursuing an undergraduate degree.
- 4) Candidate must submit OFFICIAL transcript(s) from high school, up to and including current university or vocational school transcripts, if applicable. Must include any grades through December '26. Transcripts must be submitted electronically directly by the school. High school transcripts may be emailed by a teacher or guidance counselor from an official school email address.
- 5) Candidate must submit an essay (not to exceed 2 typed pages double spaced). The student may also include a bio of extracurricular activities.
- 6) Winners of scholarship awards will not be eligible to win again the year following their award, but will be eligible the following year. Winners may be required to submit a W-9.

Completed applications must be received in full by 11:59 pm on January 7th, 2027. NO EXCEPTIONS. Only electronic documents will be accepted. If there is a situation where any documents must be mailed, it is the obligation of the applicant to request an exception from the committee by January 4th and a decision will be made. It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure all required information is received prior to the deadline.

The number of awards and denominations will be determined by the committee in conjunction with the response to our Scholarship Appeal. Please note that The Traffic Club of New York reserves the right to change the eligibility requirements at any time. See website for additional information and eligibility requirements.
